



CCCAN 2013 TIME TRIAL MEET

ASAJ SANCTION #: **021311**

VENUE: National Stadium Pool 8 Lane 50 M (with 25 M warm up pool)
Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons

DATES & TIMES: Thursday May 30, 2013 5:00 p.m.
Pool will be opened 1½ (one and a half) hours before starting time.

ELIGIBILITY: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.

Swimmers must be eligible to compete in CCCAN 2013 as per the ASAJ Selection Criteria.

- Swimmers must be close to achieving the qualifying standards for CCCAN 2013 – MUST have achieved a minimum of an AAA time.

Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2012.

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer – 2

ENTRY FEES: JA\$300.00 per individual event.

RULES: FINA Rules and ASAJ Bye-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply, except as modified in this Summons. See additional Rules and Regulations on next page.

Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists No. 15 and 16 will work the session.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 30, 2013. Entries are to be delivered to the ASAJ Office or the ASAJ Mail Box at the National Stadium Pool. Deliver as indicated above or email to: aquaticsja@gmail.com; with a copy to carletta@cwjamaica.com

Note: 1 ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE START OF MEET.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Local clubs are required to submit, with their entries, a list of volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. Clubs must submit the names of volunteers to the ASAJ Office on Thursday May 30th. Volunteers must report to the volunteer desk at least 30 minutes before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Clubs are expected to provide the following number of volunteers (non-compliant clubs will be excluded from participation):

- Two (2) - Every swimmer entered

MARSHALLING

1. There will be no Marshalling area for the meet. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
2. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
3. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

ENTRIES AND RESULTS

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group.
2. Deck entries will be allowed. A fee of JA\$400.00 per event will be charged.
3. Scratches are allowed at any time.
