



CISC 2014 TIME TRIAL SWIM MEET SUMMONS

ASAJ SANCTION #: 21410

VENUE: National Stadium Pool 8 Lane 50 M (with 25 M warm up pool)
Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons

DATE & TIME: Saturday May 17, 2014 11:00 AM
Pool will be opened 1½ (one and a half) hours before starting time.

ELIGIBILITY: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.
Swimmers must be eligible to compete in CISC 2014 as per the ASAJ Selection Criteria.

- **Swimmers must be close to achieving the qualifying standards for CISC 2014 – number 7 as per ASAJ Selection Criteria.**

Age Group ages for the Time Trial shall be as of midnight **December 31, 2013**.

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer – Two (2)

ENTRY FEE: JAS\$300.00 per individual event.

RULES: FINA Rules and ASAJ Bye-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply, except as modified in this Summons. See additional Rules and Regulations on next page.

Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists No. 16 & 17 will officiate at the Time Trial.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 17, 2014. Entries must come into the ASAJ Office at the National Aquatic Centre, Independence Park, Kingston 6 by the latest 10:00 a.m. on the morning of the Time Trial or they can be e-mailed to aquaticsja@gmail.com; with a copy to carletta@cwjamaica.com

Note: 1 ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE START OF MEET.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Local clubs** are required to submit **with their entries**, a list with the names of their volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition.

MARSHALLING

1. There will be no Marshalling Area for the Meet.
2. In the event that there is more than one heat, the next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
3. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
4. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.
