

**CARIFTA SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2012 – Nassau, Bahamas**  
**Day 3 Results**

Jamaica added one gold, two silver and one bronze medals on day 3 of the Championships, bringing the total medal haul so far to six gold, ten silver and four bronze medals. The gold medal was won by Kevaughn Campbell in the 13-14 boys 50m breaststroke event, finishing in 32.64.

Breanna Roman was second in the 15-17 girls 50m breaststroke, touching in 34.24. The 11-12 girls, Angara Sinclair and Anastazia Chin, finished second and third respectively in their 100m freestyle event. Angara's time was 1:03.13 while Anastazia touched in 1:04.30.

Other finalists on day 3 were Annabella Lyn in 11-12 girls 200m IM (2:46.86 4<sup>th</sup>), Leanne McMaster in the 13-14 girls 200m IM (2:42.68 8<sup>th</sup>), Ivana Chang in the 13-14 girls 50m breaststroke (37.73 5<sup>th</sup>) and 100m freestyle (1:04.38 8<sup>th</sup>), Matthew Lyn in 13-14 boys 200m IM (2:22.77 5<sup>th</sup>), Danielle Boothe in the 15-17 girls 200m IM (2:32.10 6<sup>th</sup>) and 50m breaststroke (35.80 6<sup>th</sup>), Brittany Kenny in the 15-17 girls 200m IM (2:33.46 8<sup>th</sup>), Breanna Roman in 15-17 girls 100m freestyle (59.68 5<sup>th</sup>), Kendese Nangle in 15-17 girls 100m freestyle (59.68 5<sup>th</sup>), Xavier Boland in 15-17 boys 50m breaststroke (32.59 8<sup>th</sup>) and Antoine Young in 15-17 boys 200m butterfly (2:21.57 8<sup>th</sup>).
