

CARIBBEAN ISLANDS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2014

Jamaica earned three (3) gold, two (2) silver and one (1) bronze medals on day 3 the Caribbean Islands Swimming Championships (CISC) in Barbados, They now have **fifteen medals - four (4) gold, five (5) silver and six (6) bronze** - and 175 points for sixth position.

Sidrell Williams won his second gold medal, this time in the 15-17 boys 200m butterfly, completing the event in 2:11.32. Also in the 200m butterfly, **Trudiann Patrick** (18 & over girls) mined gold in a time of 2:22.64. The other gold medal was won by **Angara Sinclair** in the 13-14 girls 50m backstroke. She touched in 31.47, just ahead of teammate **Annastazia Chin** who took the silver in 32.30.

The other silver medal was won by **Danielle Boothe** (31.48) in the 15-17 girls 50m backstrokes, her fourth medal of the competition. **Timothy Winter** got the bronze medal in the 15-17 boys 50m backstroke, touching in 27.79.

Other finalists on day 3 were Danielle Boothe (27.30 – 4th) in the 15-17 girls 50m freestyle, Sidrell Williams (24.41 – 4th) in the 15-17 boys 50m freestyle, Trudiann Patrick (28.13 – 7th) in the 18 & over girls 50m freestyle, Jesse Marsh (2:21.02 – 6th) in the 13-14 boys 200m butterfly and Alexia Royal-Eatmon (32.03 – 5th) in the 18 & over girls 50m backstroke.
