Women 50 metre breaststroke heats

Alia Atkinson easily navigated her way into the semi-finals with her morning preliminary swim. She clocked a smooth **29.48** to top the field heading into the semi-finals. Her time was just off the 2012 Championship record of Ruta Meilutytė of **29.44**. Reigning World Champion and main rival Ruta booked her ticket into the semi-final round with **29.72** clocked to be third.

Men 200 metre freestyle heats

Jevon Atkinson started the Jamaican campaign at the World Championships by placing second in heat 3 in **1:53.60** and 69th overall. He was out touched at the wall by Aruba's Patrick Groters who won the heat in **1:53.00**. Jevon's time was just off the all-time Jamaica best of Dominic Walter of **1:52.93**. Atkinson's split were as follows
